Once again this week was very quiet on the pension front. HB 1999 (Rep. Black) the MPERS and MOSERS cleanup bill was referred to Administrative Rules Committee, the second of the two-step process the House uses to control the flow of bills through their process. The House Pensions Committee has scheduled HB2165 for a hearing on Tuesday at 8:00 AM. HB 2165 is Rep. Ross's bill to reduce the number of MoDOT Commission appointees on the MPERS board from three to one. Senate Bill 1000 (Onder) which requires all investment decisions of public retirement systems be approved by the system's Board has not yet been assigned to a committee and I have not seen anything similar filed in the House.
