In addition, will immediately inform TEAM if an issue arises that will affect TEAM and its members.
- Attending members introduced themselves: Dave Sims, Southeast District working out of Sikeston and has been with MoDOT for 20 years. Dave Taylor, Joplin, Southwest District has been with MoDOT for 26 years. Roger Wittes, retired MoDOT employee from the Northwest District. Kelly Didiriksen, St. Louis District, with MoDOT for 19 years. Hal Smith from MoDOT's Central District. Southwest District attending via video stream, Aron Raney, 15 years, Dorothy Halbrook 2.5 years and Time Bumgardner 25 years.
- Discussion of payment schedule with lobbyist, quarterly is fine.
- Discussion of a 1.5 million dollar program which will give employees a choice of a new 401K plan or staying with MPERS; TEAM watching.
- TEAM discussed its biggest priority with lobbyist Morris, getting deferred comp reinstated.
- TEAM currently has 1,703 members; ARMSE has 2,000.
- Kelly to get email addresses and phone numbers to Lobbyist Morris.
- TEAM thanked Mr. Morris for his time.

HB 831 the now omnibus retirement bill is scheduled for the Senate Fiscal Oversight Committee on Monday at 3:00. I will be there and watch the blow by blow. Recall the two issues of concern to our members would be the 10 year vesting to 5 and the MOSERS proposed buy out of terminated vested members.

It is getting very late in session for Sen. Koenig's SB 228, hybrid plan and new tier.

The Senate was scheduled to work today, but the floor leader abruptly adjourned the Senate Thursday afternoon after an uncharacteristic very personal argument between two senators. Maybe they will cool down over the weekend and start over on Monday.

The Senate still has to adopt it's version of the FY18 budget and will probably spend considerable time on that next week. Then the conference committees will have only one week to come to agreement. Full funding of the MOSERS request is in the Senate version while the House only partially funded the request. I will be tracking the activity and keep you up to date.

There are three fun filled weeks left in session.
